Our intention is for the Mawlid gatherings and recitations to become a vehicle for people to learn something about the greatness of Sayyidna Muhammad ﷺ.

Although listening to the Mawlid recited in Arabic brings blessings and mercy upon those attending, for those who do not speak Arabic, they are missing a huge benefit that comes only with understand the meaning of the nasheeds and poems. Understanding leads to love, and love for our Prophet equates faith.
